As the most significant physical reshaping of campus to date, the Central Quadrangle project reinforces Creighton's ongoing investment in its urban setting and its student body.

The space introduces a much-needed campus heart that unifies the surrounding residence halls and academic buildings through a landscape that prioritizes community, flexibility, and connection. The quadrangle responds directly to student input calling for more green space and will provide a new home for signature events such as graduation, orientation, and alumni weekends.

- + Reclaims the site of former baseball and softball fields to create the first true campus quadrangle in Creighton's 147-year history
- + The design features a central ellipse with an art installation, a stage and amphitheater for performances, a fountain plaza, and a pavilion with outdoor classrooms
- + Social terraces with café seating and shade structures are nestled throughout the site
- + The landscape palette features diverse species of trees, shrubs, and plants that provide seasonal interest
- + The project is entirely donor-funded, and represents Creighton's investment in the broader Omaha community
