- + The park is organized around The Braid, a unifying promenade that will ultimately connect the north and south halves of the park.
- + The Braid anchors diverse recreational features, including multi-use sports fields, basketball courts, climbing structures, outdoor fitness, and two inclusive playgrounds.
- + The design emphasizes year-round use and long-term adaptability.
- + Lighting, shade, and surface materials are tailored to enhance comfort and usability as the seasons change.
- + Park amenities are arranged to support casual drop-in use, as well as organized leagues and large-scale community events.

High Note Regional Park is a dynamic 80-acre recreational hub designed to serve the rapidly growing community of Lone Tree, Colorado. The park is programmed to support a wide range of athletic and leisure activities, with a strong emphasis on fitness, sports, and play. OJB's design introduces a bold recreational framework that balances high-performance athletic infrastructure with flexible, multi-generational amenities.
